Jersey is a lot more than a little bit of Britain. It's Britain with brio, England with a generous dash of continental Europe. It's an Island that goes its own way, conjuring up an intriguing mix of sights and sounds, images and influences, all within just 45 square miles.

If ever there was a conference destination that will leave you with an enthused sensation then that must be Jersey. Located 100 miles from the English coast and only 14 miles from the French coast, Jersey has a rich cultural history of French and English rule. Jersey is also quirky. You drive on the left, but pass bright yellow phone boxes. You see country pubs and village churches, but the road names are in French.

The Island is also a renowned international finance centre with many of the world's leading banks and financial institutions represented and in excess of £180 billion invested in deposits and £170 billion in funds. With such a rich knowledge and experience in the needs of the business world, it's not surprising that Jersey is the chosen venue for numerous international conferences.



The 195 bedroom Radisson SAS Jersey on St. Helier's Waterfront will offer conference space for up to 300 delegates as well as fantastic views of the marina and Elizabeth Castle.

These two are just part of over £150 million that has and is being invested in conference led facilities.



The Hotel de France recently opened its new Ayush Wellness spa and with an investment of over £14 million there are also new meeting rooms, a bespoke cinema and tailor-made facilities making the hotel an ideal venue for product and car launches.

The 106 bedroom L'Horizon Hotel and Spa, with an enviable beachside location on St. Brelade's Bay has completed its extensive £8.5 million renovation, with an accent on contemporary designer-led style. The Somerville Hotel has also undergone extensive refurbishment and enjoys breathtaking views over the yachting harbour and the bay of St. Aubin beyond.

There is also a concentration of luxury in Jersey – in fact 3 of the AA's top rated Red Star Hotels are also found in Jersey. The sumptuous 13th Century Longueville Manor is highly regarded and has been awarded numerous accolades including in 2006 the Relais & Châteaux Welcome Trophy. The epitome of the crisp and clean appearance of classic 1930's seaside marine architecture, the 50 bedroom Atlantic Hotel is no stranger to awards and won the 2007 Conde Nast Johansens Award for Excellence in Outstanding Service. The contemporary and chic Club Hotel & Spa opened in August 2004, already rates as one of the AA's ten most highly graded hotels and restaurants in Britain. Shaun Rankin, of Bohemia, already with a Michelin Star, was also rated by Terry Durack of the Independent as British Chef of the year in 2006.

So with numerous awards and accolades as well as the huge investment, whichever venue you choose for your event, you can be assured of the highest levels of facilities, cuisine and service available.

Jersey plays host to many different types of events. Being so small the down time in Jersey is also minimal. It is not only the travel to the Island that is quick. Once you are here journeys rarely take more than 15 minutes and you are able to get more done in a shorter period of time. But perhaps the most popular private use of the castle is for evening parties with drinks on the ramparts and a marquee on the lower keep affording views of the harbour below and across the narrow channel of water to France.

The Island is also a popular choice for visiting Trade Associations, Unions, Rotary Clubs and other not-for profit organisations. The Jersey Conference Bureau offers generous support to assist these organisations to bring their events to Jersey.

The Royal Yacht Hotel and the Phytomer Spa Sirène opening in 2007 will join a roster of other fantastic Spa facilities. The Hotel de France is the first hotel in the British Isles with a spa dedicated to the principles of Ayurveda and restorative spa waters and features 8 treatment rooms. At the boutique Club Hotel & Spa you can delve into the world of Algotherm and Shankara in the 5 treatment rooms, and then unwind in The Spa relaxation room with it's soft lighting and luxurious loungers. The beachside location of the Hotel L'Horizon and Spa is harmonised by the Thalgo treatments, harnessing the riches of the sea so you can benefit from the powerful healing, revitalising and re-balancing properties, vital for health and well being.

An action packed Island, Jersey has plenty for you to choose from to enjoy yourself. Outdoor and indoor activities can be arranged for groups or individuals, for simple pleasure or for the adrenalin buzz in trying something new.

There are the tranquil pursuits of wine tasting and blending at the stunning La Mare Vineyards, trying your hand at the Jersey Pottery or taking a private tour at many of the award winning museums and places of historical interest such as the 13th Century Mont Orgueil Castle.

You could also enjoy the luxury of hiring your own private yacht and step aboard to enjoy a cruise for an evening off the beautiful south coast of Jersey. Relax and enjoy sights such as castles and old forts dating back to the 6th Century, Dead Man's Bay, towers & gun emplacements left behind by the occupying German forces after the Second World War and granite cliffs towering some 150 feet.

For the more adventurous you can try your skill at blo-karting on the five mile beach at St. Ouen. Learn to rock climb and abseil, go bass fishing in the shallows as the tide races in or try deep sea fishing. Learn to sail, scuba dive or any number of watersports. You could even take a flying lesson around the Island to really see the landscape. Enjoy an explosive team activity under the cover of darkness or perhaps be taught interrogation techniques in the dungeons at Elizabeth Castle.

Surrounded by a necklace of golden beaches, Jersey is rightly regarded as one of Europe's best locations for outdoor pursuits, and with a multitude of bars and restaurants, it is easy to see why the 'Après-Sea' scene is also enticing. With opportunities to try your hand at over 30 different activities, Jersey is a great place to develop team integration programmes. The Island will conjure up so many unique experiences for you and your delegates and is also a superb destination choice for bespoke team development programmes.

For shoppers, the capital of Jersey, St. Helier, is where busy streets, original markets, squares, lanes and pedestrianised areas create a pleasant atmosphere for browsing and buying. There are numerous festivals and events in Jersey, many in St. Helier itself, making the town a vibrant and exciting place to experience.





Using the past to enrich the future





For such a small Island Jersey has had an amazing history.

Initially part of Brittany, Jersey became part of the Duchy of Normandy in 933 and remained part of the Duchy until 1204 when King Phillippe II of France conquered the Duchy from King John of England. The Channel Islands pledged their allegiance to King John and remained in his possession given the title Peculiar of the Crown. This didn't stop the Island being a flashpoint during subsequent wars, occupied several times by the French, and recent history has been dominated by the Occupation of the Island by German troops between 1940 and 1945.

With such a lively past Jersey is constantly thinking of new and more exciting ways of bringing the Island's rich history to life so visitors can also join in the celebration of the colourful heritage.

This is very much apparent at Jersey's largest testament to its World War two occupation – the Jersey War Tunnels. A network of tunnels first created to protect arms and troops from bomb attacks by the Allies; it was then converted into an elaborate hospital to deal with casualties from any counter-invasion. In 2001 a superb multi-million pound interactive exhibition was developed that tells the true-life stories of the islanders and foreign prisoners who were involved in the hospital's construction, as well as the families who lived through the trying years of occupation and is an amazing and thought provoking insight into life during the Second World War.

The renowned Durrell Wildlife Conservation Trust also has its headquarters in Jersey. The Trust, set up by Gerald Durrell, has a mission to save species from extinction. Not only is the Trust a fascinating and great venue for team activities but you can help the Trust work to achieve their mission. Working alongside trained conservationists your delegates can assist in creating habitats which will benefit the numerous species at the Trust and the ongoing work to assure their survival.

In fact this social awareness, alongside the long recognised need to protect the fragile ecosystems on the Island, is prevalent and in 1997 Jersey became the first Island to gain Green Globe status. Furthermore the Jersey Conference Bureau also coordinates a carbon emissions offsetting programme in conjunction with Durrell to neutralise emissions caused by delegates return travel to Jersey. Recent investment of £26 million at Jersey Airport ensures a smooth and easy passage for the 2 million passengers handled each year. In addition, Jersey Harbour's modern port facilities ensure that the 440,000 passengers using this service annually can be on their way within minutes of arriving at the port.






Jersey Airport

People and Government

Jersey is not, nor ever has been, a British colony. Constitutionally, its status is that of a Crown Peculiar. Jersey is a parliamentary democracy which is a dependency of the British Crown. It is a British island, but is not part of the United Kingdom.

The Island's link with the United Kingdom and the rest of the Commonwealth is through Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, who as the Sovereign is the Head of State. The Sovereign is represented in the Island by the Lieutenant Governor, through whom official communications with the Lord Chancellor on behalf of Her Majesty's government in the United Kingdom are directed.

The States of Jersey, the Island's government, is therefore able to decide its own legal acts, including levels of taxation.

Getting started









Itinerary One

So you have a small group that you want to return invigorated, refreshed, motivated and informed. Here's one idea.

Before the trip

Day one

Day three

Itinerary Two
